- Lake Aniwanui domain and waterfall, Ngati Manawa tribal boundary.**
 Learn about taniwha (creatures who protect our waterways), hear the story of the native long fin tuna, and what our people do to ensure its survival.
- The first battle site of Tangiharuru and the Marangaranga people.**
 Learn how this ancestor secured the tribal boundaries of this land locked tribe.
- Tawhiuau, our sacred mountain.**
 Enjoy a short walk to the foothills and gather Kawakawa (traditional Medicine plants)
- Township of Murupara.**
 Learn the history of our once-thriving forestry community.
- Kaingaroa Forest** (the largest man-made forest in the Southern Hemisphere) and visit **Te Ana a Tokowaru** – the oldest Maori Rock Carvings in New Zealand, carbon dated 400 years before the Great Migration
- Kopuriki Road back to Kohutapu Lodge.**
 Learn more about the many sacred sites you pass
- Back at Kohutapu Lodge enjoy an afternoon of interactive activities including:
 - Mau Rakau** (Traditional Maori Stick Games)

- Haka** (learn all about haka, the meaning of, and how to perform “Ka Mate”)
- Weaving with Harakeke** (Native Flax)
